Samedan, Switzerland February 2010

After three years, I was (again) able to spend one week in the Engadin Valley (Kanton Graubünden), Switzerland. As a "preparation" of my school exams, I went together with my parents on winter holiday. Instead of skiing or snowboarding, I preferred to go to the winter spotting paradise called Samedan Airport, the highest airport in Europe. The airport is close to St. Moritz, where the rich and famous have their winter holiday. Below you'll find a list of all aircraft noted during the week. Please keep in mind that all aircraft are noted only once per airfield and that some aircraft paid more than one visit during the week.

In the morning of Saturday 20 February we flew from Düsseldorf to Zürich with Air Berlin (B737-700) for just €29 per person (one way, all inclusive).

First thing to do was to go to the C-office to obtain airside access, even though the fences haven't grown since 2007. After showing my online safety-test results (I completed the tests before my trip) I got a spotter badge and an orange safety vest. Airside access wasn't a problem anymore for the rest of the week. As you can see, the two hours before sunset resulted in quite some interesting aircraft. Due to a combination of fine weather, weekend and White Turf (horse racing), lots of bizzers and helicopters would visit Samedan on Saturday and Sunday.

After the sun had gone behind the mountains, it was time to go to the restaurant for a hot chocolate and a "debriefing" with the other spotters. Two of them, Hans-Peter from Bern (and the spotter-guide of Samedan) and Norbert from Frankfurt, would be at the airport for the rest of the week as well, just like me. The restaurant is called "Intersection" and is located in a former hangar, opposite of the runway intersection (hence the name...).

As one may know, the Swiss are very friendly people. The air traffic controller, Ingo, came also to the restaurant to show the spotters the expectations list for tomorrow. And that list looked very impressive...

As you can see, Sunday was one crazy day. Just a few minutes after the airport was open (8 AM), the first aircraft arrived. This would continue on for about ten hours... About seventy aircraft and helicopters were noted today. Together with the overnights from yesterday and the not noted small single engine props, one could have seen almost a hundred different aircraft in one day, amazing for such a small airport without ILS. With these amounts of aircraft, it is no wonder that the main apron was way too small. Therefore the smaller aircraft (props, Citations, Learjets and so on) had to park on the snow apron instead of the main (asphalt) apron. It was a unique sight, seeing bizjets taxiing on snow.

Because this would probably be the busiest day of the year, I was already airside at 8 AM and I didn't leave before sunset. That wasn't always easy with temperatures of about minus 20 degrees Celsius... But it was absolutely worth it, lots of awesome winter pictures could be taken from various spots, especially because the sun was shining for almost all day.

After a perfect day, the spotters went to the restaurant again for a well deserved coffee or a hot chocolate. We were showing our pictures to each other, sharing our experiences and so on. Ingo, the air traffic controller, was also there and he told us he had to reject the incoming small single engine props in the afternoon, because of the huge load of bizjet traffic...
