You can now stand on the elevated road which allows you to photograph over the fence. You're very close to the runway and a 70-200mm lens will do fine. This photo position is perfect for runway 19 arrivals and departures (backtrack) and runway 01 arrivals (backtrack). During our holiday the

runway in use was always 19 and every once in a while we had 01 arrivals. The sun is at your back here from 09.00h till 13.30h (summer time).

Highlight today was the arrival of the Falcon 7X. The local spotters Marco and Chris (www.airphototicino.ch) were also present.

The abovementioned aircraft are preserved outside but it is impossible to get a decent picture of them. There's a very ugly fence in front of the planes and due to the shadow of the buildings, you can hardly get them in the sun.

The rest of the museum is also a little disappointing, so I wouldn't spend my money on the entrance fees here.
